



Precautions for Returning to Mass

As we continue to return to public celebration of Mass, here are guidelines to ensure the safety and well-being of our community, per Bishop Mulvey’s directives.

The Sunday Mass dispensation is still in effect.

If you are feeling ill, stay home. Take your temperature before coming to Mass.

People in an at-risk population are **highly encouraged** to continue to participate in the Mass via electronic media. All St. Philip Masses will continue to be live streamed via our Facebook page.

Follow Instructions

Sanitize

Sanitize hands before entering and leaving

Wear Face Mask

Put on face mask before entering the church

Follow Ushers

Ushers will instruct you where to sit

Social Distance

Always maintain 6 feet between you & others

Communion in Pew

Priest, Deacon or EMHC will come to you

Limited Restrooms

Restroom access is limited, go at home

No Cry Room

Cry room is not available

Offertory

Basket available as you enter & exit church

Church occupancy is limited to 225 per Mass. You may be asked to attend at another time or view via online streaming.

We will be cleaning & sanitizing between Masses, so we ask that you leave the buildings immediately after Mass. No social gatherings.
